


Family Bible Time

TODAY WE WILL LEARN...

We will be reading Psalm 46 and learning that because God is our refuge we are safe and do not need to be afraid.

CREATION STATION A bible (ICB Version is brill for kids) | Air-Dry Clay | Paints

- Read: Psalm 46 verses 1 and 2.
- Ask: What does God always do in times of trouble?
- Think: What do you think it means that "God is our protection and our strength"?
- **Activity: Fort Building** | Be creative, and build a fort. You could use furniture, or you could use an empty cereal packet and design one; or you could use lego and building blocks.

WATCH THE FAMILY BIBLE TIME VIDEO

- Why was it easy to knock down our duplo friends?
- Why did it become impossible to knock them down?
- Read: The whole psalm.
- Ask: What might cause the psalm writer to be afraid?
- Explain: We might feel afraid sometimes too. Why?
- Read: Verses 7 and 11. Why can the psalm writer be confident instead of afraid? Why can we be the same?

JESUS KEEPS US SAFE

Jesus says: "My sheep listen to my voice. I know them, and they follow me. 28 I give them eternal life, and they will never die. And no person can steal them out of my hand. 29 My Father gave my sheep to me. He is greater than all, and no person can steal my sheep out of my Father's hand. 30 The Father and I are one." [John chapter 10 verses 27-30]

Be Thankful and Pray: Think of 3 ways we might be scared. Thank God, that he keeps us safe and will always keep us. Nothing can take us out of God's hands!
